

We'll soon be starting with the construction of a large pipeline in your area

Dear resident,

We'll be starting on a road works project in your area in July of this year. We'll be laying a heat pipeline underground. The street will need to be opened up for this purpose. This is the first in a series of letters you'll receive from us about the WarmtelinQ project. This letter will tell you all about what we'll be doing and when. And how these activities will affect you. Details of where you can find more information are provided below. And about how you can call, text or email us.

We'll be distributing heat from the port of Rotterdam via this pipeline.

We'll soon be able to use this heat to warm up 120,000 homes and businesses in South Holland. This will result in less CO₂ being released into the air. And that's obviously much better for nature.

The pipeline construction will start during the summer holidays.

You'll find a map depicting where the pipeline will be installed on the back. The pipeline will run from Guntersteinweg up to the De Constant Rebecqueplein. Contractor Heijmans will be carrying out the WarmtelinQ work.

We'll contact you again with more information as soon as we start working in your area.

Contractor Heijmans will always inform you exactly where and when we'll be working. You'll receive a letter with these details. You also have the option of following the activities via the BouwApp.

We'll start at various different locations from August 2023. The construction of the pipeline will be completed by the end of 2025. You may be affected by these works in different ways.

This can include noise, vibrations, dust or diversions. There may sometimes also be fewer parking spaces.

- De la Reyweg: from Monday 21st August;
- Wijkpark Transvaal and surrounding area: from Monday 21st August;
- Middachtenweg: from early October;
- Moerweg: from mid-October;
- Tripstraat: from mid-October.

We'll also be working in other places. These activities will probably only result in minimal inconveniences.

- We'll place a site hut and create a work area behind the Karwei (July);
- We'll relocate any existing gas and water pipelines in Uitenhagestraat and Herman Costerstraat (July-August);
- We'll install temporary power cabinets (June-July);
- We'll construct temporary parking spaces (July);
- We'll remove greenery (August).

Construction activities will, unfortunately, result in various nuisances. However, we try to prevent or minimise these as much as possible.

We'll do this by creating temporary parking spaces. And by cordoning off the work area with fences. That's to ensure everyone's safety. But also by, for example, setting up diversions. We'll make sure homes and shops remain accessible at all times.

We'll remove trees and shrubs. However, rest assured these will come back.

In some places there's simply not enough space for the work to be carried out. So this is where we have no choice but to remove some trees and shrubs. We'll replant these trees and shrubs once the work is done. Some of the greenery may make a return in a different place. That's simply to ensure trees aren't planted on top of the pipeline.

We'll be in Transvaal for any possible questions you may have on Thursday 29th June.

You'll be more than welcome to join us on Thursday 29th June from 18.30 to 20.30 hours. You can pop in and see us whenever it suits you. The address is Juliana Plaza, Schalk Burgerstraat 217. Do you live in Moerwijk? We'll be there for a similar session in September. We'll send an invitation for that at a later stage.
