Start of work – WarmtelinQ on the De la Reyweg

Dear resident,

On Monday 21 August Heijmans will be starting work on the road near you. We'll be laying an underground heat pipeline: the WarmtelinQ project. The pipeline will run under the De la Reyweg. We'll be carrying out the work in two parts: from 21 August 2023 to spring 2024 and between autumn 2024 and spring 2025. In this letter you can read about the work that'll be starting in August, and what you can expect.

We'll be starting the installation of the heat pipeline on Monday 21 August.

Before the pipeline goes underground, we first lay it completely ready. We'll be doing this on the De la Reyweg. Soon there'll be two pipelines of almost 800 metres long (and 70 centimetres wide) there, from the Veluweplein almost to the Dierenselaan. That's why we need a lot of space, and we're closing the De la Reyweg in the direction of the Veluweplein.

We'll be laying the pipeline in stages.

1. First we'll weld the pipe together between the Veluweplein and the junction with Kempstraat (August-October).
2. Then we'll weld the pipe together between Kempstraat and the roundabout near the Dierenselaan (September-November).
3. Finally we'll drill the almost 800-metre-long pipeline under the Veluweplein (November-December).

Going by car? Traffic heading towards the Veluweplein (south) will take a different route.

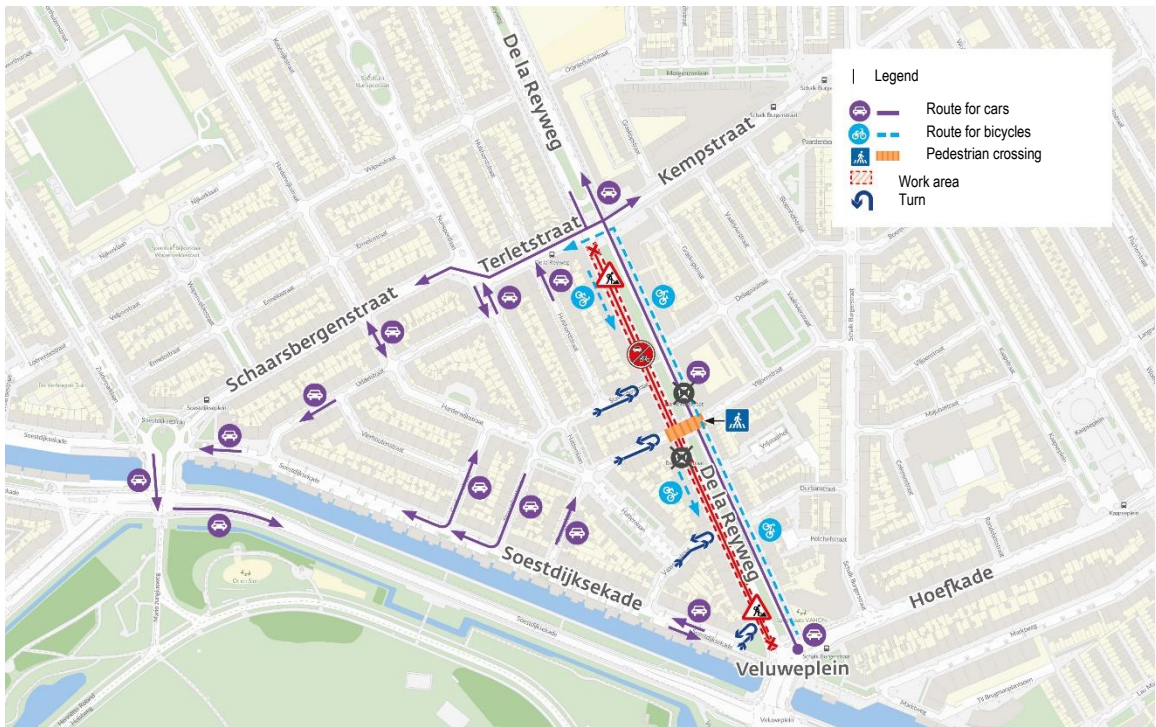
The De la Reyweg will be closed between the Veluweplein and Kempstraat. The closure will last until spring 2024. Towards Kempstraat/Dierenselaan (north), the road will remain open. The side streets will also remain open to traffic, but some streets will temporarily become dead-ends. Later in this letter you'll find a map showing the closures and routes.

Taking your bike or going on foot? The bike lanes and pavements will remain open.

There's no need to take a different route. You can cross the De la Reyweg at Kempstraat, Barneveldstraat (pedestrians only) and the Veluweplein.

Travelling by bus? Bus 26 will take a different route.

The bus will temporarily not stop on the De la Reyweg. At www.9292.nl you can see how bus 26 will be running, and where you can get on and off.



First we'll remove trees. We'll plant them back after the work.

Space is needed to lay the heat pipeline, both above and below ground. That's why shortly before the work begins we'll be removing trees along the De la Reyweg. The trees will be removed by contractor GKB. When the work is finished we'll plant back the trees and shrubs, sometimes in different places so they're not planted above the pipeline. The municipality has given permission (a permit) for this work.

Construction inevitably causes some inconvenience, but we'll try to avoid this as much as possible.

You live close to our work, so you'll probably to notice some of it. You can expect the following:



Air and dust
From windblown dust and exhaust fumes



Noise
From excavators or pumps.



Different route
The De la Reyweg will be closed towards the Veluweplein.



Closure
Some streets will temporarily become dead-ends.



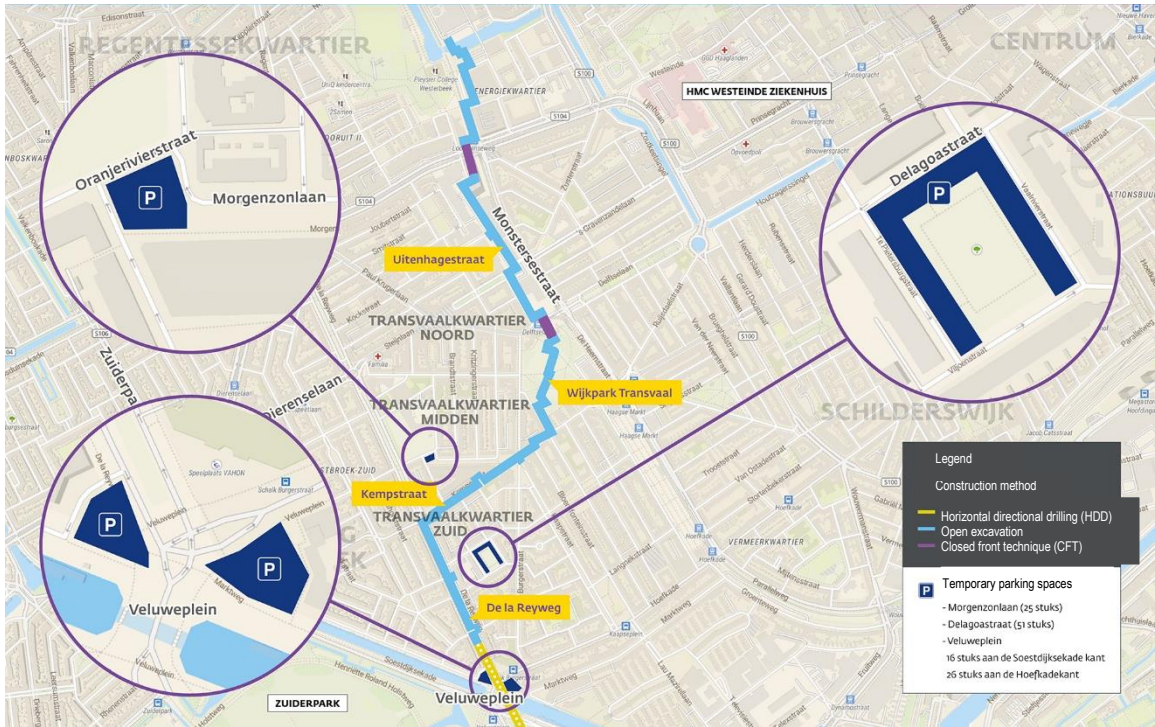
Vibrations
Our trucks will produce vibrations.




Bus will take a different route
Bus 26 will take a different route. Check 9292.nl.

A few things will be different for a while:

- Fire brigade and ambulance: homes and businesses will always remain accessible in case of an emergency.
- Underground waste containers will be temporarily closed. You'll find a sign near each closed container telling you where you can bring your waste.
- Extra parking spaces: due to our work you won't be able to park everywhere on the De la Reyweg. So we've made some extra parking spaces: on Delagostraat, Morgenzonlaan and the Veluweplein. You can find a map with the locations on the next page.
- Some disabled parking spaces will be temporarily relocated. Users will receive a separate letter about this.



In the autumn we will cordon off a longer section of De la Reyweg.
You'll receive a new letter about this in October.
